

KQHBA Minutes: June 20, 2008

President Terry Barrow called the meeting to order at Central Ky Ag Expo in Liberty.

The KQHBA will be properly registered with the Secretary of State office by June 30, 2008.

Scarlett gave a presentation of award options to the KQHBA attendees. Paul E. moved for the KQHBA to purchase the following awards: 1st place: large tote trunk with KQHBA logo; 2nd place: embroidered bridle/halter bag; 3rd place: water/feed bucket with logo; along with first and second place plaques, and 144 caps to be given thru 6th place. Rod seconded. MOTION PASSED.

It has been suggested for KQHBA members to seek donations for a silent auction.

Keith is working on rooms for the Futurity.

Terry will check to see if there is any vender cost to the KQHBA. Venders may want to come and set up a business.

The KEEP grant has been submitted.

The web-site domain has been paid.

Kristi Koch is the new web-master for the KQHBA. Her business is Equi-Promotions.

Terry has been in contact with the past CPA for the KQHBA.

Terry announced that he sent past treasurer Royce Fitzpatrick a registered letter requesting for items belonging to the KQHBA be returned. Terry read the entire letter to those at the meeting. The letter was signed for and received. It allowed 7 days for the return of the requested items. At this time, 2 weeks have past with no response.

Terry will ask advice from the Secretary of State's office and report back at the next meeting.
